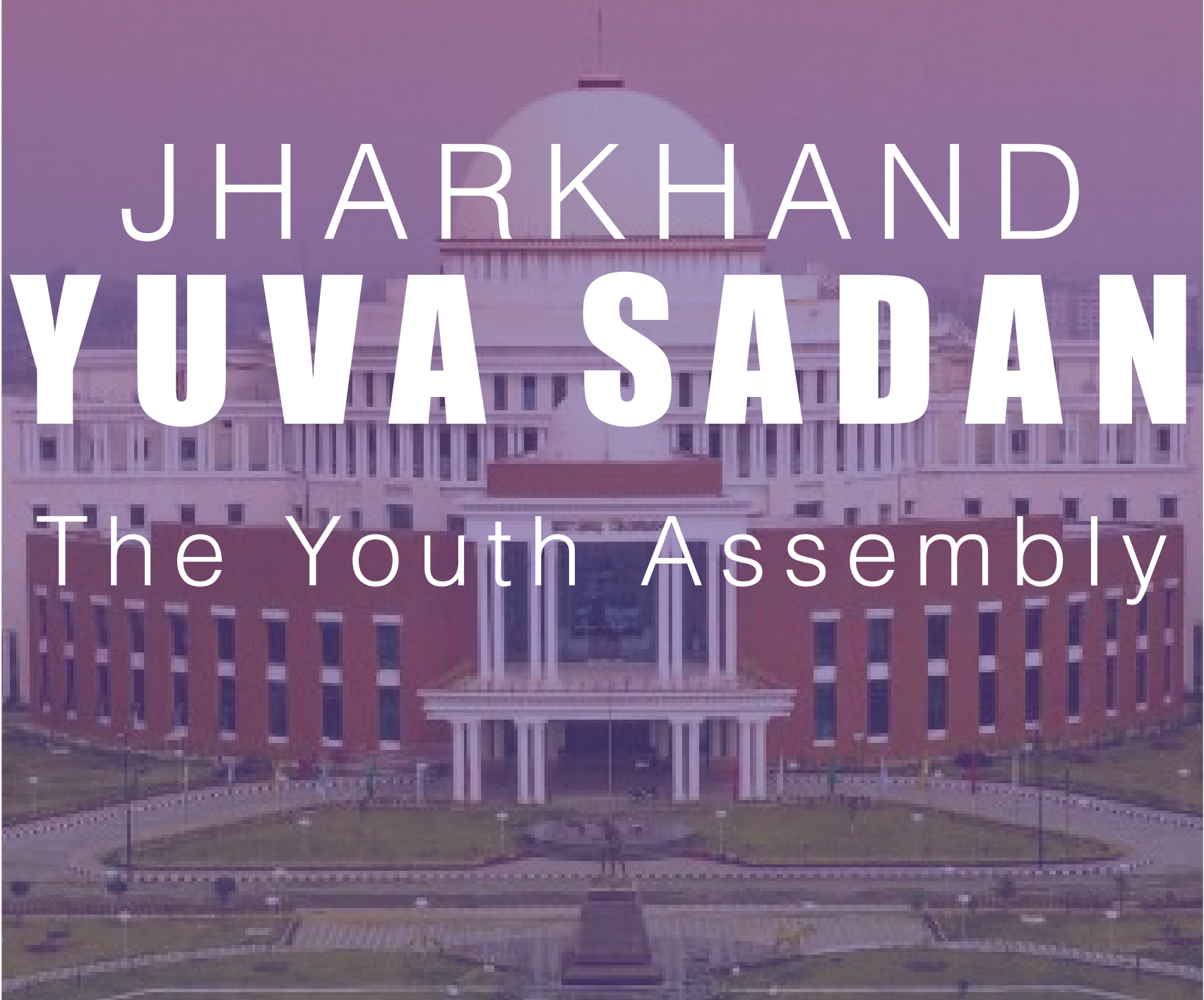



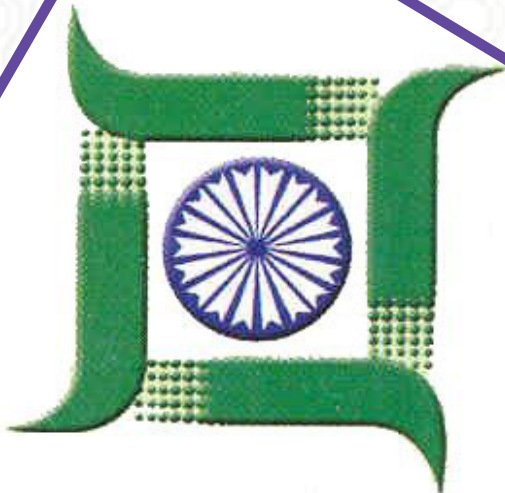

A bill to provide for quality and necessary education in the schools of the state of Jharkhand, including government schools and private schools.

The 4-Day event will act as a platform for the youth to step forward and question policy and the people who have been formulating the policy. This event is an effort to bridge the gap between policy makers of today with those of tomorrow. Our aim is to transform Jharkhand into a participative democracy and hence we chose to start from the grass-root level – the youth of Jharkhand. Through numerous seminars, workshops, simulated parliamentary debates on bills and interaction with public authorities, we get enthusiastic youth of today to understand the know-how of policy-making.

Beyond Jharkhand Yuva Sdan 2.0

“Jharkhand’s First Policy and Research Think Tank.”

We plan to develop Yuva Sadan into a policy and research organization and help the state of Jharkhand in formulation of policies and simultaneously finding public policy enthusiasts to work with the government of Jharkhand to look after implementation of government policy.

Once given opportunities and ample exposure these youth of Jharkhand can help the government and its machinery to work efficiently and cost effectively.

Yuva Sadan Organization, on the other hand, wants to promote these youth to not only understand public policy but also directly participate in policy formulation and look after its implementation.

Yuva Sadan Fellowship Programme

To live up to our idea, we are proposing to start a Fellowship Programme with the name “Yuva Sadan Fellowship Programme”. The people selected for these program will be called **Yuva Fellows**.

What is Yuva Sadan Fellowship Programme?

Yuva Sadan Fellowship programme will be a One Year Full Time Paid fellowship, where the fellows will be selected from all over India through open online application process. Through this fellowship we want our fellows to gain real life experiences in the field of public policy. This fellowship offers a short term professional opportunity, where the fellows will be engaged to work directly under the Ministers/MLAs of Jharkhand and subsequently coordinate with the local district administration. The fellows will be allotted work directly by his/her MLA or his office. They may be asked to conduct research about a particular topic, or start a new community outreach program or initiative, or prepare briefs and reports etc.

At the starting of the fellowship we propose to have a minimum of 12 fellows, who will be mostly youth in between 21-28 years of age.

Through this fellowship we aim to create a talent pool of dynamic and energetic youth who can contribute in state building. Since our focus now is only on Jharkhand, we want youth of Jharkhand to participate in large numbers. To have sufficient number of Jharkhand’s youth in fellowship we plan to offer 5 fellowships to Participants of Yuva Sadan, not necessarily the winners, but anyone who is interested may apply and 5 will be selected.

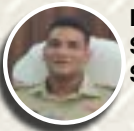

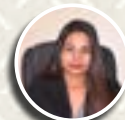

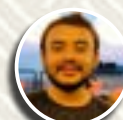

Mission Blue Foundation

Mission Blue Foundation was established in 2014, with our first initiative being focused on water conservation in Jharkhand. We struck a tie-up with a US Plant Group Company and did an extensive soil testing, the report that was later submitted to the State Government. It laid out the guidelines on water supply and suggested an optimum usage of groundwater. The Foundation's vision goes beyond the task of conserving water. We focus on creating awareness amongst the students, the youth, the farmers and the villagers of Jharkhand. We visited the majority of blocks/villages of the State of Jharkhand to aware people on water harvesting and conservation.

What sets our NGO apart from others is our inventiveness of generating employment through tribal art, culture and food. As we travelled, we found that the places were suffused with a rich tribal culture. Mission Blue Foundation pitched for this because we believe that if the culture of a place is promoted in the right direction, it can create sufficient employment for its residents.

Apart from mainstreaming the tribal and water related initiatives, we took a step to encourage the youth towards political inclination. We successfully organised Yuva Sadan: The Youth Assembly in Feb 2020 and are making efforts to make it a yearly affair.

The Foundation is also active during hour of crisis and has under taken various initiatives for the masses. It worked actively during the COVID crisis and have served food and water to around 1 lakh people in need through different relief centres spread across Ranchi and Patratu, Jharkhand. The foundation has provided dry rations to more than 35,000 families and have also arranged food, water and beverages for around 30,000 migrants returning by trains and buses in the state.


As a part of our winter campaign the foundation have distributed warm clothes to around 25,000 needy people by organising camps at various places.
