# JHARKHAND YUVA SADAN 3.0

The third edition of Yuva Sadan is Scheduled from 3rd week of May 2022 in academic collaboration with Jharkhand University Of Technology (JUT) in the State Capital in Ranchi. The 3-Day event will act as a platform for the youth to step forward and question policy and the people who have been formulating the policy. This event is an effort to bridge the gap between policy makers of today with those of tomorrow. Our aim is to transform Jharkhand into a participative democracy and hence we chose to start from the grass-root level – the youth of Jharkhand.

Through numerous seminars, workshops, simulated parliamentary debates on bills and interaction with public authorities, we get enthusiastic youth of today to understand the know-how of policy-making. ### CAMPUS AMBASSADOR & DISTRICT COORDINATOR PROGRAM:

We at Yuva Sadan want to engage maximum number of youths with our initiative and intend to reach every village of Jharkhand. To run a successful promotional campaign, we have started a program known as "Yuva Sadan Campus Ambassadors and District Coordinator Program." The aim of this program is to recruit people from every district and colleges of Jharkhand and appoint them as District Coordinator (DC) and Campus Ambassador (CA) for Yuva Sadan. These CA & DC will be the face of Yuva Sadan in their Districts and College campuses. Their work is to spread awareness about our programs and get maximum participation in our initiatives.

### JHARKHAND'S FIRST POLICY AND RESEARCH THINK TANK

#### VISION

We plan to develop Yuva Sadan into a policy and research organization and help the state of Jharkhand in formulation of policies while simultaneously providing a platform for the young public policy enthusiasts to engage with the government of Jharkhand to look after successful implementation of the said policies.

Yuva Sadan Organization wants to promote the youth to not only understand public policy but also directly participate in policy formulation and look after its implementation.

# YUVA SADAN FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

To live up to our idea that youth can be the changemakers, we are proposing to start a Fellowship Programme named "Yuva Sadan: Fellowship Programme". The candidates selected for the program will be called Yuva Fellows.



## WHAT IS YUVA SADAN FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM?

Yuva Sadan Fellowship programme will be a One Year Full Time Paid fellowship, where the fellows will be selected from all over Jharkhand through open online application process. Through this fellowship we want our fellows to gain real life experiences in the field of public policy. This fellowship offers a short-term professional opportunity, where the fellows will be engaged to work directly under the Ministers/MLAs of Jharkhand and subsequently coordinate with the local district administration. The fellows will be allotted work directly by his/her MLA or his office. They may be asked to conduct research about a particular topic, or start a new community outreach program or initiative, or prepare briefs and reports, etc. At the starting of the fellowship we propose to have a minimum of 12 fellows, who will be mostly youth in between 21-28 years of age.



## AIM OF THE PROGRAM

Through this fellowship we aim to create a talent pool of dynamic and energetic youth leaders who can contribute in state building. Since our focus now is only on Jharkhand, we want youth of Jharkhand to participate in large numbers. To have sufficient number of Jharkhand's youth in fellowship we plan to offer 5 fellowships to Participants of Yuva Sadan, not necessarily the winners, but anyone who is interested may apply and 5 will be selected.



# PANCHAYATI RAJ

Yuva Sadan believes in empowering people from the grass-roots. Villages are basic foundation of the Indian society. By empowering Gram Sabha and Panchayati Raj institutions we want to spread awareness about rights and duties of the Panchayati Raj institutions to the common Villagers. This will act as a check and balance in functioning of the Panchayati Raj institutions and also the bureaucratic machinery.

## WHAT IS PANCHAYATI RAJ?

The 73rd and 74th Constitutional amendment, shaped the existence of local self-government and gave powers in the hands of the Panchayat or the Village and Municipal council to take charge of their own affairs. The Panchayati Raj institutions thus got Constitutional authority and sanctions as guaranteed by the Parliament.



## OUR AIM

Panchayati Raj institutions are important pillars in shaping the policy for the villages. Through an empowered group of individuals, we can develop a strong Panchayati Raj system. To have good coordination with the state bureaucracy and the elected representatives it is necessary to have empowered and people centric village institutions.

## OUR VISION

Keeping in view the aforementioned objective Yuva Sadan has developed a model course for the elected representatives, the villagers and students interested in the subject matter to make them aware of the Panchayati Raj system and its functioning. The maximum duration of the course is 3 months which is specifically designed for the elected representatives to know in depth about the Panchayati Raj, its evolution, powers of elected representatives, government schemes and funding provisions, etc. We also plan to have training programs and workshops for both elected representatives and the villagers to boost their knowledge and make them aware of their rights, duties, functions and responsibilities. Through our Panchayati Raj initiative we plan to make the villagers aware and villages self-sustainable.

## LEGAL AWARENESS CAMP

Yuva Sadan organised its first Legal Aid Camp on 04th of October, 2021 at Audrey House, Ranchi. The Legal Aid Camp was organised in collaboration with Mission Blue Foundation, Jharkhand State Legal Services Authority (JHALSA), and in association with Ministry of Art, Culture, Tourism, Sports and Youth Affairs, Government of Jharkhand, and Ranchi Smart City Corporation Limited, Urban Development & Housing Department, Government of Jharkhand. The camp witnessed more than 150 participants from the field of law, law students, and interested youth.
